Order Picker Attachments - Order preparation operation or order picking as it is more commonly known is a process used within warehouse operations and consists of staff called order pickers. The order picker's duty is to take and collect articles in particular quantities to complete the client's orders before shipment. Order picking is a basic warehousing process. The efficiency in which this particular job is accomplished can be directly related to a supply chain's productivity. Thus, order picking is amongst the most controlled logistic methods. Order picking falls in the category of the warehouse management system.

There are particular kinds of order picking which consist of: pick to box method, wave picking method, piece picking or picker to part method, sorting systems method and zone picking method.

The pick to box method consists of the order picker only filling the boxes with item which are from their particular station. The box then moves on to other locations until the order is complete. In this technique, there is no movement of the order picker personnel. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move all-around in order to gather the necessary products for numerous orders. The picker to part method or piece picking is similar where the order pickers or picker move in order to gather the items required but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking workers. Instead, the stuff are brought to her or him by means of an automated system like for instance a conveyor system or an automatic storage. In the zone picking method, each order picker is assigned to one particular area. They are responsible for just realizing order picking in this specific zone.
